

Advice for handling, maintenance and storage of standard weights and masses

Handling:

Any handling of weights and masses shall be in accordance with adapted hygiene rules.

Avoid:

- taking weights of classes E and F with bare hands
- exposing the weights to dust and dirt
- storing weights in a humid atmosphere
- submitting weights to a strong magnetic fields
- pulling or pushing weights on a surface

Maintenance:

No maintenance is required.

Be carefull: Any intervention that could change the value of the mass should be avoided, for example:

- polishing
- repainting
- opening the adjusting cavity

Storage:

It is recommended to store standard weights and masses in their original boxes. Weights and masses without box shall be stored in appropriate places.
